THERMODYNAMICS

1. The first law of thermodynamics states that the change in internal energy of a system is equal to the heat added to the system minus the work done by the system.

2. For a process involving a gas, the work done by the gas is given by the area under the pressure-volume curve.

3. The second law of thermodynamics states that the entropy of an isolated system never decreases.

4. The Carnot cycle is the most efficient cycle operating between two heat reservoirs.
