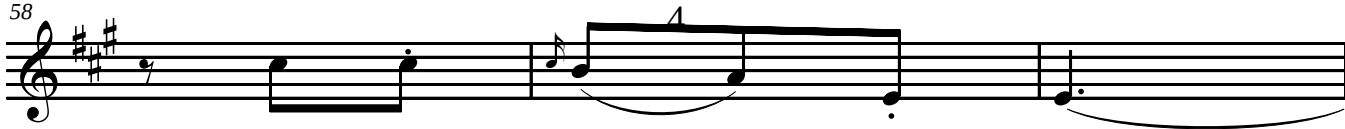
Andante.

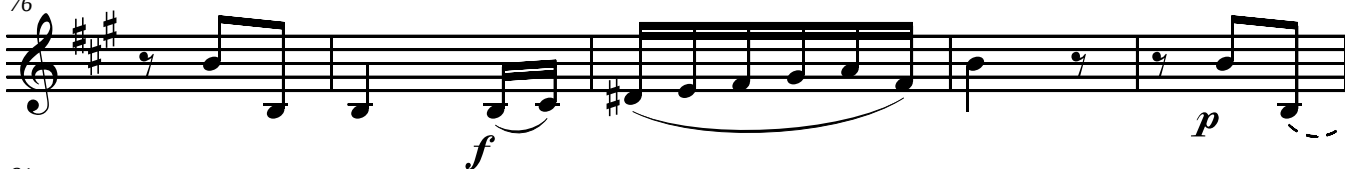

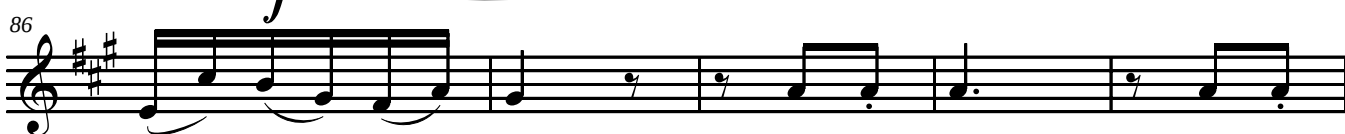
