First System:

- Trombone:** Starts with a half note G2, followed by eighth notes A2, B2, C3, D3, E3, F3, G3, A3, B3, C4, D4, E4, F4, G4, A4, B4, C5.
- Bass Trombone:** Rests throughout the first system.

Second System (Measures 7-12):

- Tbn.:** Continues the melody with eighth notes and quarter notes, including a sharp sign (F#4) at measure 8.
- B. Tbn.:** Rests throughout the second system.

Third System (Measures 13-18):

- B. Tbn.:** Rests throughout the fifth system.

Sixth System (Measures 30-34):

- Tbn.:** Continues the melody with eighth notes and quarter notes, including a sharp sign (F#4) at measure 32.
- B. Tbn.:** Rests throughout the sixth system.
