3. Trou noir

(Black Hole)

- 1) Play chord silently. While holding chord, slowly release the sustain (right) pedal and then press sostenuto (middle) pedal with left foot.
Hold sostenuto pedal until the end of the piece.
 - 2) Let the strings sustained by the sostenuto pedal resonate as long as the sound produced is audible and of musical interest.
