| pinyon/piñon | evergreen tree              | ?Spanish?            | lowland nut tree                 |
| ponderosa    | evergreen tree              | Spanish (from Latin) | heavy (tall), mid-elevation tree |
| bristlecone  | evergreen tree              | English              | high-altitude ancients           |
| Kanab        | creek / canyon / town       | Paiute               | willow                           |
| Nankoweap    | creek / canyon / cliffhouse | Paiute               | singing, or echo                 |
| Shinumo      | tribe / butte / wash        | Paiute? or Hopi?     | peace?                           |
