Violino I score for Vivaldi's *Il Teuzzone*, Sinfonia [RV 736]. The score is written for Violino I and consists of 27 measures, numbered 28 to 54. 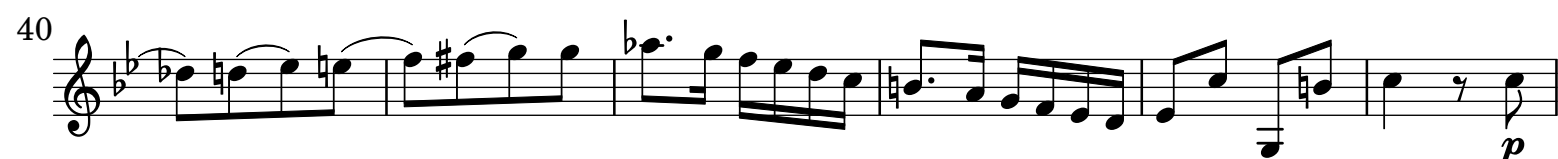
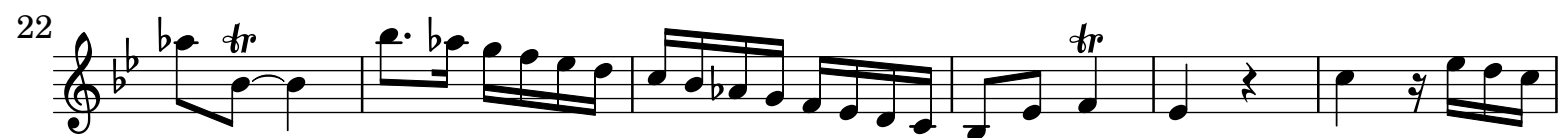
