Notes for performers

- Pronunciation of the text is to be based on British pronunciation. For example, “Pleiads” is to be pronounced as /plí:ədz/.
- “su”, “bah”, “loo” is from the word “昴”(*subaru*), which is the Japanese word for the Pleiads.

Program note

The piece starts with an image of the Pleiads in the night sky painted by the choir, with syllables from the Japanese word for the Pleiads—“昴”(*subaru*). The seven-note figure in the tenor represents the seven stars of the Pleiads while the treble and the bass draw the clouds running above the horizon.

This motif returns constantly giving the feeling of a long night while the Pleiads travel towards the west. The piece is painted with colors and rhythms from each word, segment, line, stanza and overall atmosphere of the poem. While my impression of the poem is very calm, beautifully dark and quiet, I also wanted to express inner cries of solitude.
