
## Sailing Homeward

Chang Fang Sheng was a 4th Century Chinese Poet. In 1918 Constable and Alfred Knopf (New York) published Chan Fang Sheng's Poem Sailing Homeward in the translation of Arthur Waley. It is public domain in the USA. Arthur Waley died on 27th June 1996 and his work became public domain in Canada on 1.1.2017.
