Die vorliegende Edition basiert auf einer Handschrift aus der Staatsbibliothek zu Berlin-Preußischer Kultubesitz. Nach RISM handelt es sich um eine Kopistenabschrift eines **Te Deums** von **Johann Franz Xaver Sterkel (1750-1817)**¹, das 1793² nach der Rückeroberung von Mainz durch preußische Tuppen komponiert wurde. Es enthält ein autographes Titelblatt mit der Widmung: *Composta nella Occasione della Espugnazione della/ Città e fortezza di Magonza per le Arme Prussiane / li 22di Luglio nell' anno 1793/ et umillissimamente dedicato/ alla Sua Maestà il Re/ del Giovanni Francesco/ Sterkel/ Maestro di Capella/ alla Corte di Magonza.*³

Kritischer Bericht

I. Die Quelle

Das Autograph des **Te Deum D-Dur** (Fis S 117) wird heute in der Staatsbibliothek zu Berlin-Preußischer Kultubesitz unter der Signatur **KHM 5356** aufbewahrt.

II. Zur Edition

Die Vokal- und Instrumentalstimmen wurden in der Partitur entsprechend der Vorlage⁴ angeordnet. Die originale Schlüsselung ist, wenn von dieser in der Edition abgewichen wird, folgendermaßen dokumentiert: Soprano = Sopranschlüssel, Alto = Altschlüssel, Tenore = Tenorschlüssel. Die Tromben, Timpani und Hörner in C wurden in der Originalversion für alle Teile übernommen und müssen in den abweichenden Tonarten entsprechend transponieren.

Ergänzt wurden Taktzahlen. Die Schreibweise des Textes ist ohne Nachweis dem heutigen Usus angeglichen worden. Bindebögen wurden konsequent der Quelle folgend übernommen, gegebenenfalls bei Diskrepanzen zwischen den Stimmen nachgetragen. Gleichfalls ergänzt bzw. angeglichen wurden dynamische und Vorzeichen betreffende Angaben⁵. Alle weiteren Ergänzungen des Herausgebers wurden in den Noten diakritisch gekennzeichnet.
