The first system of the hymn features vocal staves and piano accompaniment. The vocal parts (Soprano, Alto, and Tenor/Bass) enter with the lyrics "O Lord, thou art my God, I will ex-". The piano accompaniment provides a steady harmonic support. Crescendo markings (*cres.*) are placed above the vocal staves at the end of each line, indicating a build-up in volume.
